What is a Maple Leaf World School Program Authorized School?

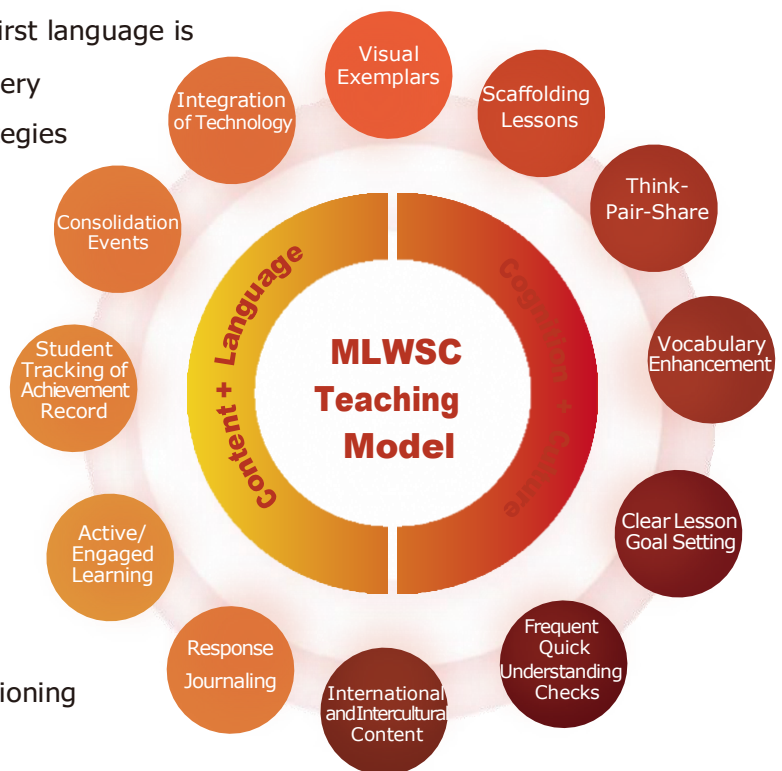
As a Maple Leaf World School Program (MLWSP) Authorized School, you will be able to:

What is the unique Maple Leaf World School Curriculum?

MLWSC is a unique academic, university-prep, English language program specially designed for students whose first language is not English, and home culture is not western. Every course embeds 12 key teaching and learning strategies that are identified as the most successful for these types of learners. This innovative curriculum promotes English proficiency and academic excellence through a dynamic and engaging learning environment that emphasizes higher-level thinking and inquiry-based learning. What teaching and learning resources does a MLWSP Authorized School receive?

An Authorized School receives access to the full MLWSC. Access to the MLWSC, however, is far richer than access to other international or government curricula. Access to other curricula means access to the curriculum's standards, curriculum content, and at times some required learning processes. In addition to these items, the MLWSC provides Authorized Schools' teachers complete access to all course overviews, unit plans, sample lesson plans, and hundreds of teaching and learning resources filed by course, unit, and lesson plan number. All teachers in Authorized Schools have full access to this wealth of resources for every course in the MLWSC.

The MLWSC permits two local courses per year to be included, which are native country language, history, or culture courses. These courses may be taught in English or in the official language of the country.

What accreditations does the MLWSC hold, and are its graduates recognized and accepted by top universities around the world?

Overall conclusion: Ecctis' independent review has found the MLWSP High School Diploma, awarded by Maple Leaf Educational Systems (MLES), comparable to:

- Overall GCE A Level standard in the UK system, when five Grade 12 MLWSP subjects have been passed (in addition to the Personal and Global Leadership and Creative Thinking and Problem Solving courses)
- British Columbia Certificate of Graduation standard
- US High School Graduation Diploma standard.

Holders of the MLWSP Grade 12 diploma may be considered to meet the general entry requirements of undergraduate admission in the UK, Canada and US.



Exceptional university admission success of MLWSP graduates

The high quality of the MLWSP is also demonstrated by the exceptional success of its graduates consistently gaining admission into top universities around the world. For the last three years, Maple Leaf has been graduating approximately 800 grade 12 graduates per year. 100% of the graduates received university offer letters. In 2023 80% and in 2024 85+%% and in 2025 90+% of MLWSP grade 12 graduates received admission letters from the top 100 QS ranked universities in the world.

What is the process for a school to become a MLWSP Authorized School?

The process for a School to become a MLWSP Authorized School is as follows:

- ✿ School submits a completed application form
- ✿ MLWSC Authorization Committee holds a Zoom meeting with the School's governance and administrative personnel
- ✿ MLWSC Authorization Committee conducts a preliminary on-site inspection at the School
- ✿ School signs an MLWSC Authorization Agreement and authorization is granted for the School to implement the MLWSC
- ✿ MLWSC Authorization Committee conducts an on-site inspection; after which the School is authorized to issue the MLWSC transcript and diploma

What fees are MLWSP Authorized Schools required to pay?

Associated fees (in US dollars) are:

- ✿ \$1,000 one-time application fee
- ✿ \$7,500 annual administrative fee
- ✿ \$200 per-student annual curriculum and resources fee
- ✿ Pay transportation costs and \$500 per day professional fees for School inspectors
