

❁ The Maple Leaf World School Program

The Maple Leaf World School Program (MLWSP) is an academic, university preparatory, English language High School Program designed for international and domestic learners. The innovative curriculum emphasizes academic excellence through a diverse, dynamic, engaging learning curriculum that includes higher-level thinking skills and inquiry-based learning, resulting in graduates being prepared for success at reputable universities and serving as contributing global leaders and citizens. Students are taught in English by certified teachers. Twelve key teaching and learning strategies, which are most helpful for academic learners whose first language is not English and whose home culture is not Western, are embedded in all Maple Leaf World School Curriculum (MLWSC) courses. All these factors contribute to the exceptionally high rate of success achieved by Maple Leaf High School graduates.

The Maple Leaf World School Curriculum is benchmarked by ECCTIS. ECCTIS is the UK's National Information Centre for global qualifications and skills. It offers official UK national agency services on behalf of the UK government in global qualifications and provides independent evaluation of curricula and diplomas and comparative benchmarking services to education providers, government agencies, and professional bodies across the globe. ECCTIS conducted an in-depth comparative review of the MLWS grade 10-12 curriculum with high school programs in the UK, USA, and Canada and concluded that:

"Holders of the MLWSP Grade 12 diploma may be considered to meet the general entry requirements of undergraduate admission in the UK, Canada, and US. The MLWSP High School Diploma is comparable to the overall GCE A Level standard in the UK system when five Grade 12 MLWSP subjects have been passed (in addition to Personal and Global Leadership and Creative Thinking courses). The MLWSP High School

Diploma is comparable to British Columbia Certificate of Graduation standard. The MLWSP High School Diploma is comparable to the US High School Graduation Diploma standard."

In 2025, Ecctis benchmarked the MLWSP Curriculum and Diploma with the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE). Ecctis has found the MLWSP High School Diploma is comparable to HKDSE standards. This study built on the previous benchmarking of MLWSP in 2024, which found that the MLWSP High School Diploma was overall comparable to the UK GCE A level, the British Columbia Certificate of Graduation, and the US High School Diploma.

Maple Leaf World School's rigorous inspection, accreditation, and curriculum benchmarking ensure a high-quality learning environment for the ultimate benefit of its students.

Another significant evidence of the high quality of the MLWSP is also illustrated by the exceptional success of its graduates being admitted into top universities around the world. 100% of the graduates receive university offer letters. The following percentages received offers of admission from QS top ranked 100 universities in the world:
